






There are 12 penitentiary institutions in RA with capacity to accommodate 5346 prisoners or detained persons.










# Inmate/prisoner involvement in self-initiated associations

No participation in awareness rising/self-development associations




No participation in religious associaitions


















## Would you agree to study with prisoners/former prisoners?
